**Under this agreement for 2018
Kirwan State High School will receive**

\$885,856*

This funding will be used to

- Maintain 100% Year 12 students achieving a QCE/QCIA.
- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students achieving a C or better in both English and Mathematics to 85% .
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2 bands in Year 9 NAPLAN reading and numeracy test to 13%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A or B in both Effort and Behaviour to 40% in all subjects in all year levels.

Our initiatives include

- Continue to improve attendance, effort and behaviour in all year levels.
- Continue to implement data walls to track students' progress and collaboratively analyse data to inform differentiated instruction.
- Continue to build teachers' capacity to teach reading and writing in all subject areas.
- Enhance the school's numeracy program to extend students capacity to problem solve.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ an additional 9.28 FTE \$742,000 to:
 - Increase Guidance allocation
 - Fund 2 x HOC positions
 - Fund 5 x Peer Coaches
- Continue to engage external reading, writing and numeracy coaches \$25000
- Provide professional development for teaching staff \$6000
- Continue to employ one CEC \$70000
- Continue to employ additional Teacher Aides to support the school's reading, writing and numeracy programs \$42856
