This funding will be used to

- Maintain 100% Year 12 students achieving a QCE/QCIA.
- Increase the percentage of Year 8 and 9 students achieving a C or better in English and Mathematics to 80%.
- Increase the attainment of A or B in each Year 8 and 9 cohort in English and Mathematics to 35%.

Our initiatives include

- Implement a school based Junior Certificate of Education (JCE) to effectively monitor student progress and provide targeted intervention where needed.
- Continue to improve attendance and engagement in all year levels.
- Continue to build teachers' capacity to analyse data to improve student outcomes.
- Continue to implement data walls to track students' progress.
- Continue to build teachers' capacity to teach reading and writing in all subject areas.
- Continue to implement the Junior Secondary Reading Program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ an additional .8 Guidance Officer \$108,854.
- Continue to engage external reading, writing and numeracy coaches \$80,650
- Continue to employ an IT Technician to support the Head of Department Data Analysis and School Improvement \$88,000.
- Appoint two Heads of Curriculum to work with the Heads of Department Teaching and Learning \$255,106.
- Continue to employ one additional CEC \$61,600.
- Continue to employ five additional Teacher Aides to support the school's reading and writing programs \$207,760.
- Provide professional development and TRS for classroom observations \$27,007.
- Employ a .8 literacy teacher \$83,213.
