**Under this agreement for 2017
Kirwan State High School will receive**

\$837,770

This funding will be used to

- Maintain 100% Year 12 students achieving a QCE/QCIA.
- Increase the percentage of Year 8 and 9 students achieving a C or better in both English and Mathematics to 85%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2 bands in Year 9 NAPLAN reading test to 10%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A or B in both Effort and Behaviour to 60% in all subjects in all year levels.

Our initiatives include

- Continue to improve attendance, effort and behaviour in all year levels.
- Continue to implement data walls to track students' progress and collaboratively analyse data to inform differentiated instruction.
- Continue to build teachers' capacity to teach reading and writing in all subject areas.
- Continue to implement the Junior Secondary Reading Program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ an additional 1.6 Guidance Officer.
- Appoint two Pedagogical Coaches to work with the Heads of Department Teaching and Learning.
- Employ a .8 literacy teacher. Total teaching staff \$446,475
- Continue to engage external reading, writing and numeracy coaches \$80,650
- Continue to employ an IT Technician to support the Head of Department Data Analysis and School Improvement \$88,000.
- Continue to employ two additional CECs \$134,000
- Continue to employ additional Teacher Aides to support the school's reading, writing and numeracy programs \$85,579
- Provide professional development for teaching staff \$3066
