Foreword

This Selection Guide provides specifications and configurations for the devices offered in the 2026 round of Hire to Buy Device (H2BD) at Kirwan State High School. The completion and return of the *Selection and Payment Form* on the back two pages of this document is all that is required to confirm involvement in H2BD 1-1 Program or Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) for 2026.

The 1-1 Program (H2BD and BYOD) offered by Kirwan SHS is explained in more detail in the *Kirwan SHS H2BD/BYOD Handbook* document which is available on the school website. This *Selection Guide and Order Form* should be read in conjunction with the *Handbook* document.

Participation in H2BD is conditional upon participation in the *Student Resource Scheme*.

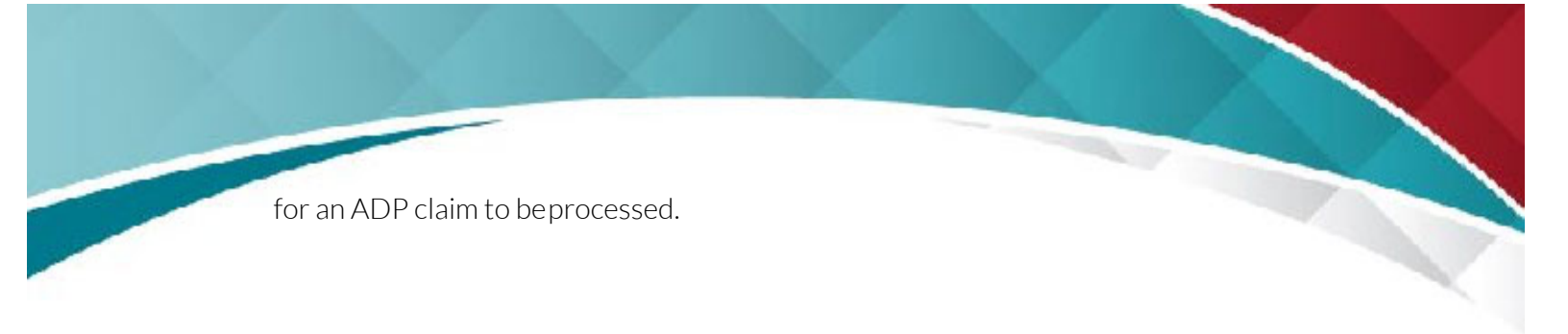
The devices offered in this selection come with a 3-year warranty (including battery) and 3 years Accidental Damage Protection (ADP). Prices of devices usually change once at the start of a month, the manufactures are trying to continue this process. Due to recent events the prices are increasing, and the manufactures will need to increase the prices Mid-month to keep up with market prices. Prices are given as requested and orders must be submitted at the start of the last full week of the month.

Refer to the *later sections of this* document for any points of clarity regarding support offerings, device ownership, software, etc. On completion of the Order Form; if selecting a H2BD option, you will be receipted for the H2BD Participation Agreement and an order placed for your selected device.

Payment in full or the 1st year payment with your signed Participation Agreement form needs to be completed before Laptop order is placed. Laptops will be distributed to students throughout Term 1 2026.

Accidental Damage (ADP) Terms and Conditions Summary

- \$0 excess on claims.
- A maximum of one (1) claim per 12-month period commencing from the start date of the term of the Service Contract (effectively one claim per calendar year).
- Claims do not accumulate or carry over to any subsequent 12-month period.
- Additional ADP claims within the same 12-month period will be repaired at the vendor's full parts and labour costs. These repair costs will be passed on to students/parents.
- ADP does not cover accessories (Laptop case, Digital pen); however, these accessories can be purchased through the school.
- Balance of ADP coverage (along with warranty) is transferrable. (Particularly relevant if student leaves the school within 3-year warranty/ADP period). There may be a small transfer fee applied.
- Decisions on ADP coverage are made by a third-party insurance provider. Adequate details of the incident causing damage is required on the claim form



for an ADP claim to be processed.

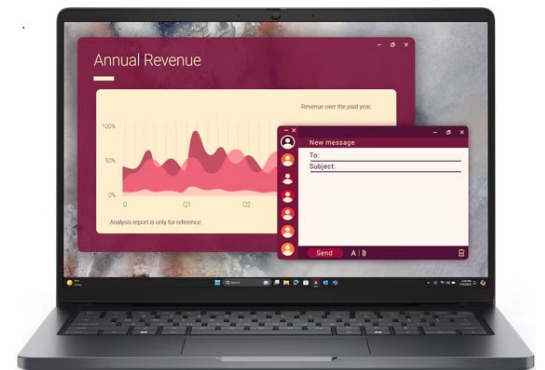
Option 1:
