Kirwan State High School

School Enrolment Management Plan

Kirwan State High School [2] (https://kirwanshs.eq.edu.au/) recognises as its prime obligation, the provision of access to an appropriate educational service for students whose principal place of residence is within the school's catchment area.



Because of enrolment capacity and growth, Kirwan State High School may be unable to meet this obligation in the future unless action is taken to manage enrolments. The principal must restrict the enrolment of out-of-catchment students to ensure in-catchment students can enrol at their local state school without requiring additional facilities.

Student enrolment capacity

Kirwan State High School has a maximum student enrolment capacity of 2,225 students.

The school's Programs of Excellence in the Creative Arts Academy (art, dance, drama, Indigenous art, instrumental music and music), and Sports Academy (AFL, basketball, football, general academy, hockey, netball, rugby league, touch and volleyball), and STEM Academy (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) are supported through the allocation of a defined number of places. Places in the Programs of Excellence will only be available to out-of-catchment enrolments once the demand for in-catchment enrolment has been met and sufficient student enrolment capacity has been reserved for future in-catchment growth. Currently Kirwan State High School has the capacity to enrol:

- 300 in the Creative Arts Academy Program of Excellence
- 800 in the Sports Academy Program of Excellence
- 300 in the STEM Academy Program of Excellence.

Local catchment area

A school's local catchment area is the defined geographical area from which the school is to have its core intake of students.

Kirwan State High School operates under an equidistant catchment area.

Out-of-catchment application

Out-of-catchment students applying for enrolment at the school are placed on a waiting list, assessed in order of receipt and prioritised as follows:

- For schools with a Program of Excellence
 - Subject to available student enrolment capacity, places will only be available to outof-catchment enrolments if they satisfy the school's criteria for placement in that
 particular Program of Excellence and the defined number of places has not yet
 been filled by enrolments from within the catchment. Sufficient student enrolment
 capacity must be reserved for future in-catchment growth. (Please note: The
 enrolment criteria for the Programs of Excellence are available from the school.)
- All other out-of-catchment enrolment applications.

Enrolment policy and procedure

The enrolment policy (/parents-and-carers/enrolment/management-plans#enrolment-policy) includes further information about in-catchment and out-of-catchment enrolments, acceptance and assessment processes, as well as any associated fees and decisions on enrolments.
