SYNOPSIS

Welcome to the amazing world of Dr Seuss. *Seussical* is an amalgamation of many of Seuss's most famous children's stories, with the majority of its plot being based on *Horton Hears a Who!* The Cat in the Hat is our narrator who tells the story of Horton, an elephant who discovers a speck of dust floating through the air and realizes that there are people living here, so small they can't be seen - the tiny citizens of Whoville. Horton vows to help them and places Whoville safely onto a soft clover. The Whos include the Mayor's son Jojo, a Who child sent off to military school for thinking too many "thinks." Horton and Jojo hear each other and become friends when they realize their imaginations are so much alike - they have found that "one true friend in the universe who believes in me."

The rest of the jungle thinks Horton is losing his mind, except for his neighbour, Gertrude McFuzz, who is not noticed by anyone, least of all Horton. Horton faces a double challenge: not only must he protect the Whos from a world of naysayers and dangers, but he must guard an abandoned egg, left in his care by the irresponsible Mayzie La Bird. Although Horton faces ridicule, danger, kidnapping and a trial, the intrepid Gertrude McFuzz never loses faith in him. We follow Horton's adventures as he persists to protect Whoville, despite what others think of him and the challenges in his way. Ultimately, the powers of friendship, loyalty, family and community are challenged and emerge triumphant and we are reminded that "if you open your mind, oh, the thinks you will find".
