

## LEVEL OF ENGAGEMENT

Level of Engagement acknowledges students who consistently contribute to a positive school culture by demonstrating the school's expectations. Students can lodge an Appeal at the end of each reporting period if they wish to dispute their Level of Engagement.

G R E N	<ul> <li>Description Outstanding students who always demonstrate a commitment to achieving personal excellence in the classroom and have a positive influence on our school community are at this level. On the Green level, a student may: <ul> <li>Be presented with a Gold Award if they maintain this level for both Term 2 and 3 reporting.</li> <li>Be selected to represent the school at an official function.</li> <li>Be nominated for a student leadership position.</li> </ul> Criteria - Students meet all of the following conditions <ul> <li>Excellent or Very Good for all Effort and Behaviour results, with a maximum of 2 exceptions.</li> <li>Attendance Rate at 90% or above with approved absences.</li> <li>No School Disciplinary Absence</li> </ul></li></ul>
Y E L L O W	<ul> <li>No School Disciplinally Absence</li> <li>Description</li> <li>Students who consistently demonstrate a commitment to learning are at this level.</li> <li>On the Yellow level, a student may:</li> <li>Be selected to represent the school at an official function.</li> <li>Continue to hold a student leadership position.</li> <li>Apply to have their Level of Engagement reviewed through their year level Head of Department of Student Services or Deputy Principal.</li> <li>Criteria</li> <li>Students do not meet the criteria for red or green.</li> <li>Attendance Rate at 80% or above with approved absences.</li> </ul>
R E D	<ul> <li>Description Students who are working towards an improved commitment to learning are at this level. While on the Red level, a student may: <ul> <li>Not be able to represent the school in any area (e.g. sport, cultural, representative school sport).</li> <li>Apply to have their Level of Engagement reviewed through their year level Head of Department of Student Services or Deputy Principal. </li> <li>Criteria - Students meet one or more of the following conditions <ul> <li>3 or more Needs Attention or Unacceptable Effort and/or Behaviour results.</li> <li>Major breaches of the Student Code of Conduct.</li> <li>Attendance Rate below 80% with approved absences.</li> </ul> </li> </ul></li></ul>
