Rationale

Each year level is a critical stage of education for students.

The Year Level Certificate will:

- Provide incentive for students to improve academic achievement and celebrate student success.
- Encourage students to take greater ownership and responsibility for their learning.
- Ensure students are prepared for a pathway that will assist them in achieving high academic outcomes.
- Support students to set goals and identify personal strengths and areas for improvement through ongoing tracking of success.
- Enable staff to effectively monitor and track student achievement and inform support and intervention strategies.

Structure of Year Level Certificate

Students in Years 7 to 10 will have the opportunity to achieve a Year Level Certificate.

1 credit is awarded for each subject that a student passes in each semester.

Students must pass a semester of English and a semester of Mathematics in order to achieve a Year Level Certificate.

Years 7 & 8 Credit System

Students must attain at least 12 out of a possible 16 credits to be awarded a Year Level Certificate.

Awarding of Year Level Certificate

Year Level Certificates of Education are awarded at the annual awards ceremony.

Students are also eligible to be awarded certificates of Merit and Excellence at this ceremony if they meet the criteria.

Tracking and Monitoring

The Head of Department (Student Services) tracks and monitors student performance data.

In addition to this, they will coordinate intervention processes for students at risk of not achieving a Year Level Certificate.

Non-achievement of Year Level Certificate

When a student does not achieve the Year Level Certificate, they will still progress to the next year level. However, a non-achievement of the Year Level Certificate will indicate to staff that additional support may be required in future years.
