This qualification reflects the role of individuals who assist with the delivery of sport and recreation activities and who complete a range of fundamental customer contact and maintenance duties. They work under direct supervision to complete mainly routine tasks.

This qualification provides a pathway to work for any type of sport, aquatic or recreation organisation including commercial, not-for-profit, community and government organisations.

This is a one-year course delivered in Years 11 and 12 delivered on site at Kirwan State High School through external RTO Binnacle Training.

Assessment

Assessment is competency based and completed in a sport and recreation environment.

Units of competency are clustered and assessed in this way to replicate what occurs in a sport and recreation work environment as closely as possible.

- Projects
- Video Lectures
- Written and Practical Tasks

Work placement

Students are provided with the opportunity to do structured workplace learning where they will work in a real sport and recreation environment.
